Established in 1972, Search and Care is a non-profit, non-sectarian social service agency. Our mission is to seek out vulnerable, primarily homebound older people in the community who need help managing life's daily activities and accessing essential services, while ensuring they can age at home and live independently for as long as possible. Search and Care provides comprehensive, fee-free care management and supportive services, as well as the companionship needed to enable older adults to live with dignity and peace of mind.

Since our founding more than 53 years ago, we have assisted over 22,000 at-risk older New Yorkers living primarily in the Upper East Side, Upper West Side, and East Harlem communities. Search and Care receives limited public funding, relying primarily on private contributions. Our Annual Benefit is an important source of funding for the vital fee-free programs and services that Search and Care provides to older adults in our communities.
